Residential and office building, Cologne

The building complex consists of a six-story brick-covered front building and a four-story row of buildings structured by "glass joints". Large glass façade elements alternate with contrasting brick and rendered façades. In the front building's two-floor arcade area, which is primarily glass-enclosed, 400 square meters of office space is being created. The interior of the block contains five attractive town and atrium houses. The simple cubes feature hidden atriums and recessed balconies or terraces enclosed by hornbeam hedges. Despite the high urban development density, private spaces and protected semi-public areas were created that support neighborly communications.
